The office also supervises the German Honey Association, the Honig-Verband e.V. and its European umbrella organization, F.E.E.D.M., as well as the German Seafood Association, Deutscher Seafood Verband e.V. The sales achieved by the members amount to approximately 10 billion euro per year.
